> Yes - I'm sorry this is so rush-rush. I had mentioned it to Kathy some time ago but didn't follow up. Actually I didn't think it was so important because we hadn't had anyone for a long time. But I asked FEMA to clean up our board list as it had gotten messed up and gave them the list of current board members without the old county representative who I think retired some time ago. So now they caught up to us and won't release the money.

> This is the Emergency Shelter and Food Program ESFP (formerly known as FEMA) local Board of Directors. YCAP is the non-voting administrator of the funds but the ESFP Board for the county is very specifically named - i.e. someone presenting Red Cross, UW, Salvation Army, any Tribal within the county, a Jewish rep, a Christian Churches rep, etc. The Board can meet 4 times a year or 2 times a year. YCAP sends out all the notices, organizes the applications, etc. The Board reviews the applications, determines the amount of money each agency gets. YCAP files all the paperwork and ensures that the agencies get their reports filed in time. The county dollar amount has fallen from the mid-\$60,000 a year to just slightly over \$40,000 this year. And ESFP keeps getting later and later getting notice out to us so they are now actually a year behind. Funding is for emergency food, emergency shelter or emergency utilities only. Agencies receiving funding cannot preach or require church service attendance to those clients receiving assistance. Typical agencies receiving funding in the past are Henderson House shelter, the food bank, YCAP shelters, Thugz Off Drugz shelter, Love, INC, etc.
