

### MEMORANDUM

TO: Bidders and other interested persons

RE: Notice of Intent to Award a Contract to Haworth, Inc. for the Public Works Vehicle Washing Station Renovation Project

On March 20, 2014, at 2:00pm, Yamhill County opened proposals submitted in response to its Request for Proposals for Design and Construction Services for the Public Works Vehicle Washing Station Renovation Project.

Two proposals were received, one from Andy Medcalf Construction Company, and the other from Haworth, Inc. The proposal of Haworth, Inc. of McMinnville was awarded the most points, and is also the lowest cost proposal. Andy Medcalf Construction Company's proposal was for \$118,223, and Haworth, Inc.'s proposal was for \$89,000.

On March 27, 2014, the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners adopted Board Order 14-174, tentatively accepting the proposal of Haworth, Inc. and authorizing this notice of intent to award. This memorandum constitutes Yamhill County's notice of its intent to enter into a contract for Design and Construction Services for the Public Works Vehicle Washing Station Renovation Project with Haworth, Inc.

Any protest of this notice of intent to award a contract for Design and Construction Services for the Public Works Vehicle Washing Station Renovation Project must be filed with the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners at the above address not later than 5 pm on Thursday, April 3, 2014. Any protest of this notice of intent to award will be managed by the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners or its designee.
