YAMHILL COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE
Worden Hill Road Through Truck Recommendation
July 10, 2014 RIAC meeting

BACKGROUND

Following the paving of Worden Hill Road, it has been brought to the attention of the Public Works Department (PWD) and the Road Improvement Advisory Committee (RIAC) that large trucks are using Worden Hill Road as a short cut between Highway 99W and Highway 240. It is important to accommodate destination trucks that service the many businesses on Worden Hill Road. However, Worden Hill Road was not designed as a truck route, and through truck traffic is especially problematic with long log trucks using this narrow, steep road with sharp curves.

RIAC RECOMMENDATION

At its July 10, 2014 meeting, RIAC approved the motion to recommend to the Board of Commissioners that 'No Thru Trucks' signs be posted on Worden Hill Road. This will accommodate local truck delivery service, but will curtail unsafe heavy truck traffic from using it as a through access road.
