

I'm happy to confirm that Active Transportation Section can provide up to \$362,000 for the expected shortfall on Yamhelas Westsider Trail. This will be additional Transportation Alternatives (TAP) funds for completion of PE and ROW work as described in the current IGA. I'll work with you to calculate and confirm a specific amount after you provide an updated cost estimate showing the amount of shortfall. We also need to confirm that Yamhill County or their partners can cover the 10.27% local share of the total.

Once we confirm the amount and the match, we should aim to have an IGA amendment drafted and ready for signature by the end of February. At that point, we can amend the additional TAP funds into the new 2015-2018 STIP, and execute the IGA amendment soon afterward.

Please contact me with any questions about next steps for the additional funds.
