SUBJECT: Vehicle Replacement

Recently Sheriff Tim Svenson contacted me about replacing patrol vehicle P-245. P-245 is a 2007 Ford Crown Victoria with 134,000 miles. He requested the replacement vehicle to be equipped with all-wheel drive. After looking at several all-wheel drive police pursuit type vehicles we determined the Ford Interceptor Utility vehicle would be the best fit for the Sheriff's Office. It is equipped with a V/6 engine that will get similar fuel mileage to our current Dodge Chargers. Although the initial cost is more than the current Dodge Charger the all-wheel drive utility will have a greater residual value which will help offset the initial cost.

None of our local dealers have this type of vehicle in stock. Chuck Colvin Ford of McMinnville offered a unit that is located in California that would have shipping costs. They also offered a new Interceptor Utility that would arrive in 90 days. I talked with our Sheriff and he is ok with a 90 day delivery if it saves money and we buy local.
