Hi Mary and Laura,

I would like to request Board Consideration to approve the attached Contract Employee agreement between Yamhill County Health and Human Services and Deborah Flensburg, a Psychiatric Behavioral Health Nurse Practitioner. If approved, Ms. Flensburg will be compensated at a rate of \$80.00 per hour without benefits, and anticipated start date is November 16, 2015.

Because this position was originally budgeted as an Independent Contractor in the Professional Services account line in our 2015-2016 Adopted budget, and is now being filled as a contract employee, we will need to request an increase in position management authority by .75 FTE for a Registered Nurse III (Psychiatric Behavioral Health Nurse Practitioner). This is a cost neutral shift.

I recommend approval of this agreement as written as well as the position management authority request. Please let me know if you have any questions.

Lucy, please place this agreement on next week's Board Agenda for approval. The original agreement will be coming over by interoffice mail. Board agenda language for two separate agenda items:

"Approve position management authority increase of .75 FTE equivalent for a Registered Nurse III (Psychiatric Behavioral Health Nurse Practitioner)."

"Approve an agreement between Yamhill County Health and Human Services and Deborah Flensburg to provide professional psychiatric behavioral health services."
