The Parks Board currently has one vacancy. Galen McBee of 625 NE 11<sup>th</sup> St., McMinnville recently applied for membership to the Parks and Recreation Board. Mr. McBee attended the Parks Board Meeting on December 7, 2015 to present his application for consideration and introduce himself as a prospective Board Member.

Mr. McBee was an active member of the Parks and Recreation Board since May 16, 2007 (appointed by Board Order 07-125) until his second term expired on May 16, 2015. During his first term, Mr. McBee served as the Vice-Chair for the last 2 years and excelled in this capacity. Mr. McBee brings many years of parks and recreation experience (retired McMinnville Parks Director and the only Board Member with a park named after him) and he is an avid cyclist. Together, this experience has made him the ultimate resource in all aspects of park planning, development, and operations.

On September 10, 2015, the Parks and Recreation Board bylaws were amended in B.O 15-376. The amendment under Article 4 Membership and Quorum allows Board members to now serve additional four year terms upon approval of the Board of Commissioners.

At the December 7, 2015 Parks Board meeting, the Board deliberated and voted, unanimously, to recommend the appointment of Galen McBee to the Yamhill County Parks & Recreation Advisory Board.
