Hi Mary and Laura,

I am requesting Board Consideration for Incentive Pay at 5% for Marie McDaniel-Bellisario effective retroactively to 7/9/16 due to additional leadership duties within the Quality and Clinical Advisory Council (QCAP) of the Yamhill CCO over and above the routine management of the Adult Behavioral Health Division which currently has 69.78 full-time equivalent staff. The Adult Behavioral Health Division organizational chart is attached for reference.

These specific functions are related to program development with Medication Assisted Treatment and other CCO opioid harm reduction initiatives, as well as the oversight of new program development under contract with Provoking Hope for the NARCAN administration efforts. The duties are in alignment with our strategic goals to reduce the harmful effects of substance abuse in our community. This was included in the 2016-2017 HHS Adopted budget.
