Hi Mary and Laura,

I am requesting ratification of the attached award acceptance letter which I signed on June 28, 2016. This award is in response to our application to support development and start-up costs associated with the Substance Use Disorder Day Treatment with Housing Support Services. Permission to apply for funding was approved under Board Order #16-20.

Additionally at this time, I am requesting authorization to sign the required documents related to the development award of \$182,619. These documents include the Promissory Note, Trust Deed, required escrow documents and lien on the property for the 30 year term.

The total award amount of \$228,523 is included in our 2016-2017 Health and Human Services Adopted budget. The start-up funds will be awarded separately.

This award letter supersedes the award letter dated June 2, 2016.

Dear Mr. Silas-Halloran Steiner:

I am pleased to inform you that the Health Systems Division (HSD) has conditionally approved a Day Treatment with Housing Support Services Award in the amount of \$182,619.00 for the Day Treatment with Housing project located in Yamhill County. These funds are for the development of a 6 bed capacity program for Day Treatment with Housing Support services for individuals with substance use disorder.

It is important to note that the funds cannot be used to refund or reimburse any expenses or costs that occurred prior to the date of this award letter.

The award was approved with the following conditions, some of which require your immediate written response:

1. Management Plan. Provide a detailed description of the proposed management plan.
2. Project Development Budget. Submit a budget that identifies cost for all proposed housing development activities (acquisitions and construction). Identify sources and uses of resources that will finance the housing development. Provide a brief status of each funding source (i.e. committed,

application pending, etc.).

3. Project Schedule and Development Plan. Submit a revised project timeline schedule. **Please use the attached report format.**
4. Monthly Progress Reports. Provide HSD with a monthly progress report on the development of your project. **Please use the attached report format.**
5. Start-Up and Monthly Operating Budget. The Start-Up and Monthly Operating Budgets submitted in the application proposal package will serve as the initial draft budgets. Final budgets will be negotiated with the HSD Housing Development staff.

Submit Start-up Budget. **Please use the attached form.**

6. Use of Funds. Awarded funds must be used to support Day Treatment with housing support services for Medicaid and Indigent individuals with substance use disorders. Approval of the award was based on the application that was received in response to the solicitation dated December 1, 2015. Please inform HSD immediately, if the project changes. This includes changes to your budget documents that exceed 10 percent for any budget category and any changes in funding commitment amounts.

Oregon statues mandate that these funds be expended by June 30, 2017. If you will not use your award by this date, please inform HSD immediately. Your award will be withdrawn for this biennium.

7. Annual Confirmation Reports. After completion and occupancy of your project, HSD will conduct monitoring on an annual basis. As recipient of the award you will be asked to complete a confirmation report to document the continued use of the property for the agreed purpose.
8. Occupancy. The Award is conditioned on occupancy of the project occurring no later than **May 30, 2017**. This deadline may require modification prior to

completion of the project. If approved, extensions will be made in the form of an amendment to the Agreement extending the deadline as needed.

Please Note: if an extension is needed past this date, ongoing future funding for Housing Capacity Support (\$24 per diem) will NOT be awarded for the 2017-2017 biennium.

9. Appraisal. A complete copy of an appraisal from a licensed appraiser showing the current market value to support all funding sources.
10. Funding Sources. Submit verification of all participating funding sources for the project prior to disbursement of the awarded funds.
11. Securing State's Interest. HSD requires that investments in real property acquisition or improvement be secured. Execution of a Community Housing Development Agreement, Promissory Note and Trust Deed will be required. HSD reserves the right to require additional document to meet security requirements. The Promissory Note and Trust Deed will be for a term of 30 years. The Trust Deed will be recorded in the respective county. Upon your request, these documents will be available for your agency to review before closing.

The equity value on the subject property must support all secured lien positions. Any project that reflects a negative equity margin must be secured by additional collateral approved by HSD.

12. Disbursement of Award. Awarded acquisition funds will be disbursed through an escrow account using a title company located in the state of Oregon acceptable to HSD. Award recipient is responsible for any fees associated with this transaction. Unless the parties agree otherwise in writing, the Closing shall occur no later than May 30, 2017.

Complete and return the enclosed Title Company Information form designating the title company that will be handling this transaction.

13. Insurance Requirement. HSD requires that insurance be maintained for the life of the award. Insurance requirements are:

- **Real Estate Hazard Insurance:** coverage on all real estate in the amount of the full replacement cost (equal to current appraisal).
- **Liability Insurance:** coverage in an amount not less than **\$2,000,000** combined single limit coverage and **\$4,000,000** aggregate; with an insurance company satisfactory to HSD.
- **Flood Insurance:** *if* any portion of the real estate is located in a flood hazard zone, flood insurance, or other appropriate special hazard insurance, is required in the amounts equal to the lesser of the insurable value of the property or the maximum limit of coverage available.

Complete and return the enclosed Designation of Insurance form. This allows HSD to work directly with your insurance agent to obtain the insurance requirements prior to funding (or project completion).

14. Confidentiality Agreement. Complete and return the enclosed Confidentiality Agreement.

15. Other Requirements. Submit the following information;

- a. Confirm Site and how this site will best meet the needs of the Population.
- b. Provide a revised Monthly Operation Budget which includes mortgage amount. **Please use attached format.**
- c. Site control will be required within 3 months of issuance of this award letter. Provide a timeline where this will be obtained as well as an occupancy date of no later than May 30, 2017.
- d. Provide verification of cash contribution source along with appropriate

approval for use of cash. If Yamhill County HHS is contributing cash to the project, a copy of the resolution approval is needed stating the amount of funds approved as cash contribution to the project.

16. Award Acceptance. Within 15 days from the date of this award letter initial each page, sign the letter and return the original indicating your acceptance of the Award and all the terms and conditions (a copy is enclosed for your records).

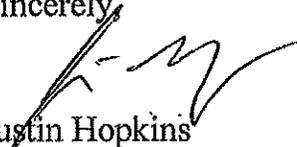
