WHEREAS, School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options;

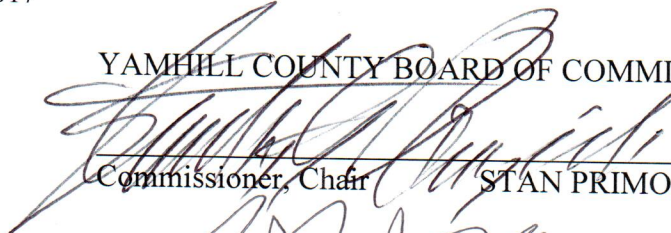
NOW, THEREFORE, the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim the week of January 22nd through 28th, 2017 as

YAMHILL COUNTY SCHOOL CHOICE WEEK

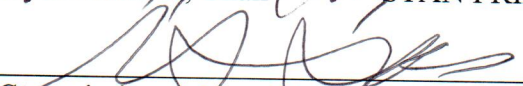
in Yamhill County, and in doing so encourages all citizens of Yamhill County to call this observance to the attention of all of our citizens.

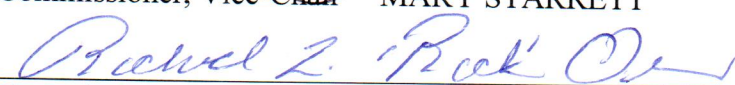
