Hi Mary and Laura,

I am requesting permission to apply for a General Program Funding grant through Providence Health & Services Community Health Division to support development of a peer-assisted crisis center. The program will serve five to seven adults at any given time and will provide intensive mental health treatment and stabilization for medically stable individuals experiencing mental health crises. The goal is to create a calm, non-institutional recovery-oriented setting that can serve as a diversionary alternative to acute care or jail while providing the services necessary to support these individuals to remain in the community safely. The grant request will be for \$150,000 and is included in own FY 2017-2018 proposed budget.

If our application is successful, I will return to the Board to request approval for the actual amount awarded.
