Shares are distributed on an annual basis, based on the employee's earnings over the previous calendar year. No one person can hold more than 1.0% of the shares. The shares are held in trust, and purchased back from the employee upon retirement.
- 8) How many people does your business employ? Recology Western Oregon - Valley employs 21 drivers. The parent company, Recology Western Oregon, employs an additional 20 shop and administrative personnel. The admin personnel also serve the company's other subsidiary operations located in Astoria, Warrenton, and North Tillamook County. Some administrative staff also provide limited services to related party operations in Portland, Aumsville, and Ashland, Oregon.
- 9) Summarize your experience in providing solid waste service: Recology Inc. has been in the solid waste collection business for over 100 years. We pride ourselves on our status as a leader in innovative waste management and diversion strategies, while keeping our focus on providing excellent service to our customers.

Other: Medical Waste collection, short-term rental of containers and debris boxes for residential and commercial use, other related services not listed here (see rate sheets).

- 18) Frequency of collection service proposed:

Residential: We offer weekly, every-other-week (EOW), once-a-month (OAM), and will-call collection service in 32 gallon and 96 gallon roll-carts. Some remote areas of the county are not served on a weekly basis, but only have EOW or OAM frequencies available.

Commercial: In addition to the cart services listed above, commercial customers can order front-load container services ranging from 1.0 to 8.0 cubic yards, with collection frequency up to 6 days/week (as well as weekly, EOW, OAM or will-call).

Industrial: We offer debris box services on both a scheduled and a will-call basis, depending on the customer's needs. Customers can either use our boxes or provide their own, so long as the customer-provided boxes are compatible with our equipment.

Other: Medical Waste Collection and other related services (see rate sheets for details).

- 19) Recycling services proposed: Residents with at least OAM trash service are eligible for EOW collection of mixed recyclables in a 96 gallon roll-cart. Motor oil is also collected curbside. Commercial and industrial customers are offered recycling services that match their needs, which may include carts for mixed recycling or glass, front-load containers for cardboard, and 10-40yd debris boxes for metal, wood, cardboard or other materials. Our main recycling center, located at 2200 NE Orchard Avenue in McMinnville. In addition to the materials collected curbside, this depot also offers drop-off for glass bottles and jars, car batteries, books, textiles, electronics, and many other items. Appliances, anti-freeze, and tires are collected at this site for a fee.

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20) Disposal sites to be used: Currently, garbage is delivered directly to Riverbend Landfill. We are working to complete construction of a full-service transfer station on our property (2200 NE Orohard Avenue, in McMinnville). Depending on the status of Riverbend Landfill, we may divert waste collection in the unincorporated County to this transfer station. From there, waste would be transported to another site, located elsewhere in Oregon or Washington.

21) Will your company be collecting any hazardous or industrial waste, as defined by federal, state, and local law? No hazardous waste will be knowingly accepted for collection. Hazardous wastes identified after collection will be handled according to applicable laws, rules, and regulations. Waste from industrial sources will be collected, provided that the material is deemed to be acceptable by the final disposal site. Wastes requiring special handling or equipment will be handled/charged accordingly, unless such tasks are outside our abilities and equipment, in which case the customer would be referred to a special/hazardous waste contractor for removal of the specific materials.

23) If unacceptable wastes are collected, describe plan for storing and removing them: Drivers will follow the directions of the disposal site or transfer station staff regarding necessary actions to segregate the unacceptable waste.

None at this time, but we continue to look for opportunities to improve and expand the services we provide to our customers. This may include, but is not limited to, collection of yard debris or glass bottles & jars curbside from county residents. We are also hoping to divert debris boxes from demolition and construction projects to our Transfer Station, so the materials can be recovered for reuse or recycling.

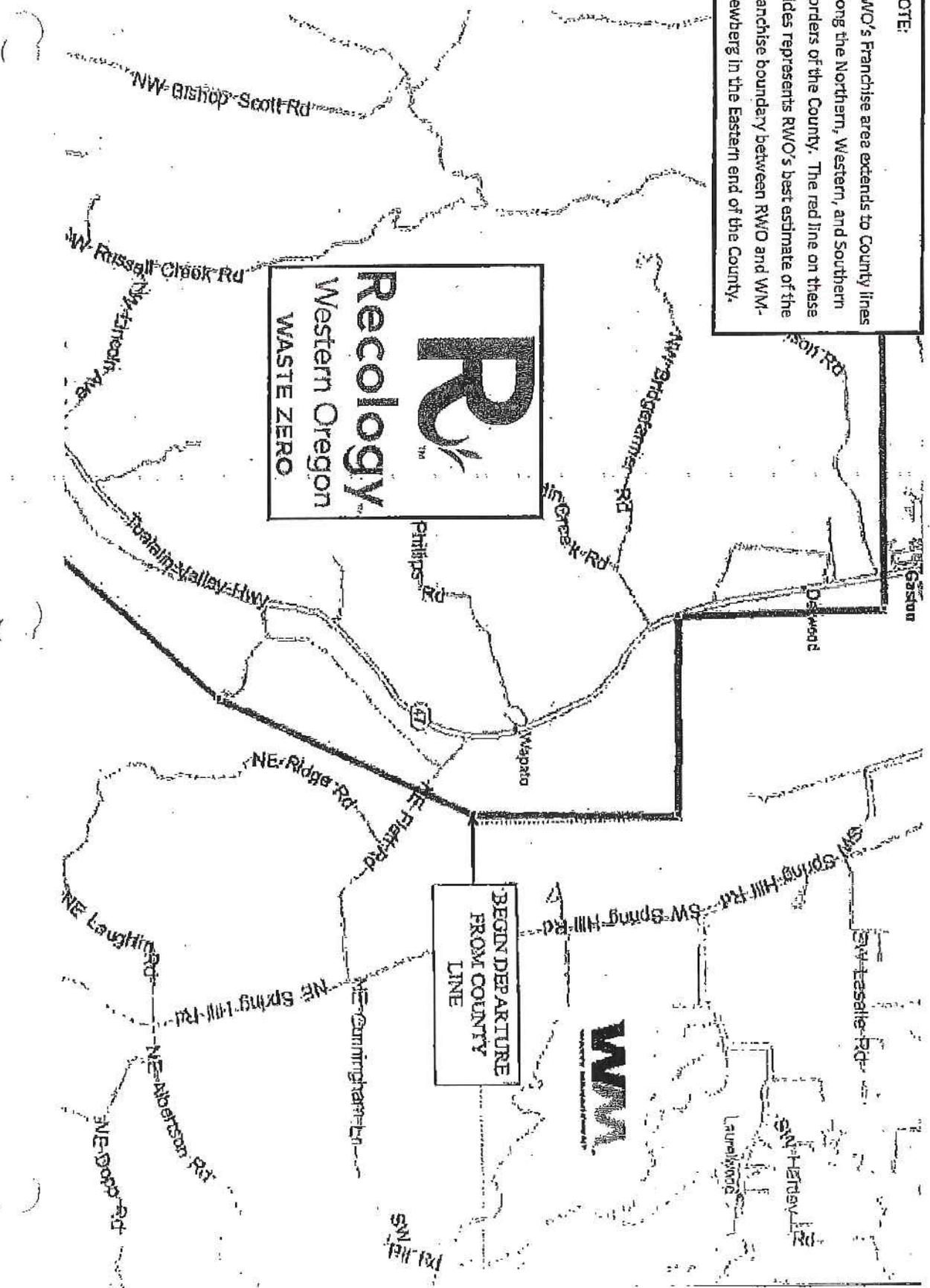
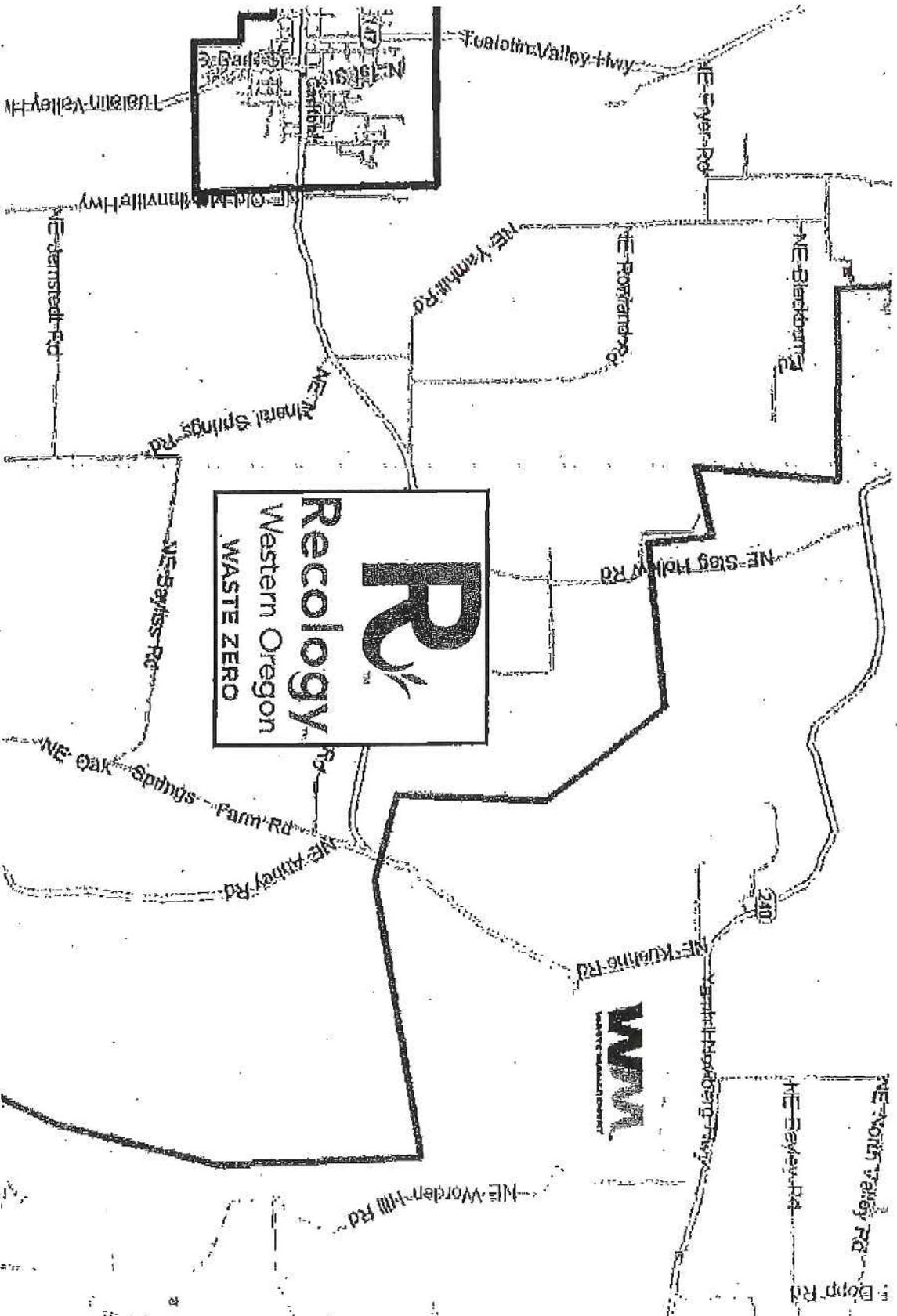

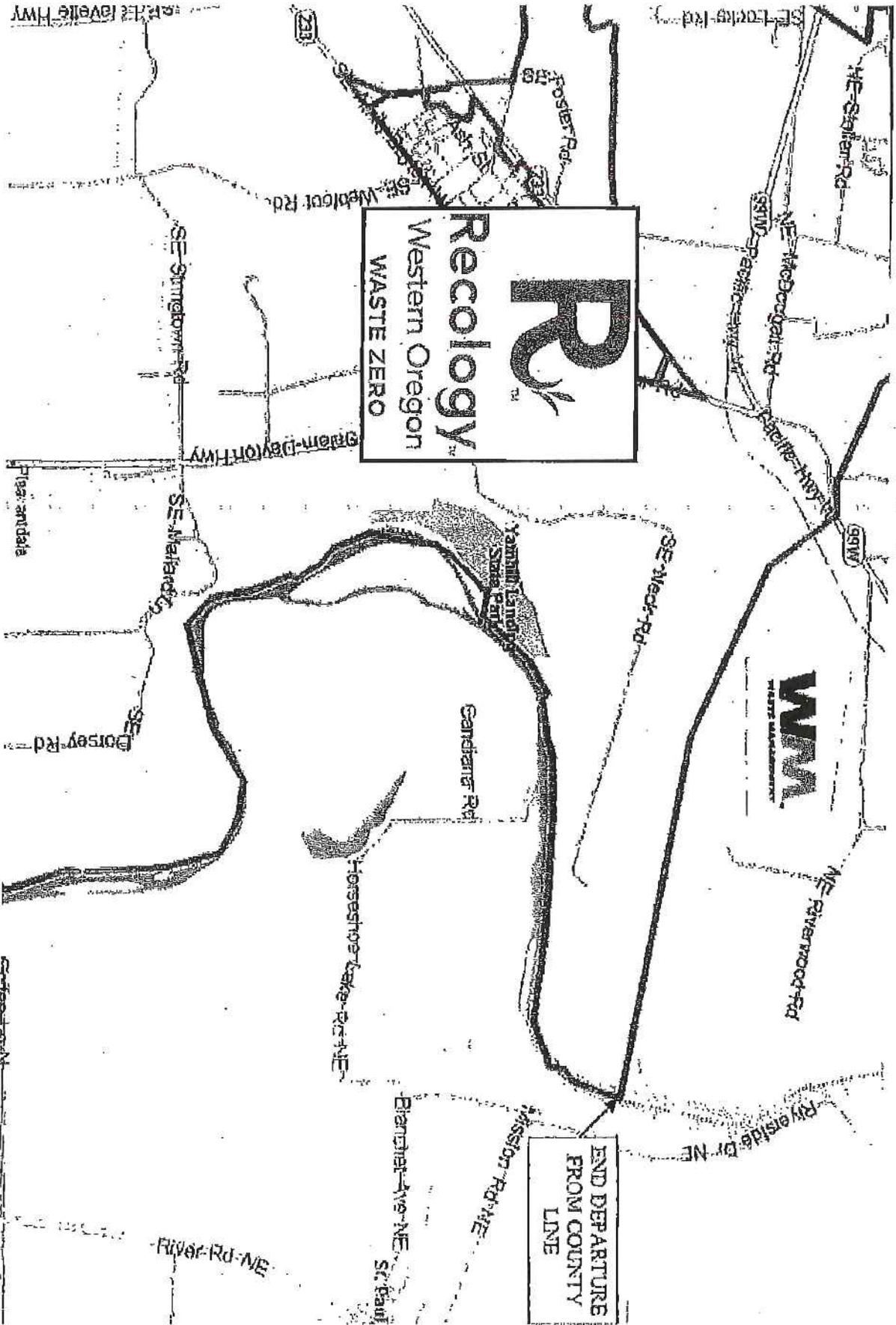
Yamhill County - RWO Franchise Area

(1) **Accounting Policies**

(a) Organization

Recology Oregon Waste - Valley Inc. (the "Company"), is a wholly - owned subsidiary of Recology Oregon Inc., which is a wholly - owned subsidiary of Recology Inc. (the "Parent" or "Recology"), which in turn is wholly - owned by the Recology Employee Stock Ownership Plan (the "Recology ESOP" or the "ESOP").

(b) Revenue Recognition and Accounts Receivable

The Company recognizes revenue on an accrual basis when services are performed. Deferred revenues primarily consist of revenues billed in advance that are recorded as revenue in the period in which the related services are rendered. The majority of the Company's revenue is subject to rate regulation by the municipalities in which it operates.

The Company's receivables are recorded when billed and represent claims against third parties that will be settled in cash. The carrying value of the Company's receivables, net of the allowance for doubtful accounts, represents their estimated net realizable value. The Company estimates its allowance for doubtful accounts based on several factors, including historical collection trends, type of customer, existing economic conditions and other factors.

(c) Property and Equipment

Property and equipment, including major renewals and betterments, are stated at cost. It is the Company's policy to periodically review the estimated useful lives of its property and equipment. Depreciation is calculated on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of assets as follows:

Depreciation expense on the above amounted to \$26,939 for the year ended December 31, 2016. The cost of maintenance and repairs is charged to operations as incurred; significant renewals and betterments are capitalized.

(d) Environmental Remediation Liabilities

The Company accrues for environmental remediation costs when they become probable and estimable, normally based on its best estimate within a range. If no amount within the range appears to be a better estimate than any other, the low end of such ranges is used. Remediation costs are estimated by environmental remediation professionals based upon site remediation plans they develop and on their experience working with regulatory agencies and the Company's environmental staff and legal counsel. All estimates require assumptions about future events due to a number of uncertainties, including the nature and extent of any contamination, the appropriate remedy or remedies, the final apportionment of responsibility among the potentially responsible parties, if any are identified, the financial viability of other potentially responsible parties, and regulatory agency requirements. Thus, actual costs incurred may differ from the Company's initial estimate. These estimates do not take into account discounts for the present value of total estimated future costs, as the timing of cash payments is not reliably determinable. The Company regularly evaluates the recorded liabilities when additional information becomes available or regulatory changes occur to ascertain whether the accrued amounts are accurate. The Company does not recognize recoverable amounts from other responsible parties or insurance carriers until receipt is deemed probable. No environmental liabilities were accrued at December 31, 2016.

(e) Impairment of Long-Lived Assets

The Company's policy is to review estimated undiscounted future cash flows and other measures of asset value for its operations when events or changes in circumstances indicate the carrying value of an asset may not be fully recoverable. If an asset is deemed impaired, a loss is recognized.

During the year ended December 31, 2016, there were no events or changes in circumstances that indicated the carrying value of an asset was not fully recoverable.

(f) Income Taxes

Effective October 1, 1998, the Parent elected to become an S corporation with the Company electing to be treated as a Qualified Subchapter S corporation subsidiary. Under S corporation rules, the Parent's taxable income and losses are passed through to the ESOP, the Parent's sole stockholder, which is exempt from income tax, and the Company is treated as a division of the Parent having no separate income tax obligations. The Parent has not allocated the income tax expense to the Company.

The Company recognizes income tax positions only if those positions are more likely than not of being sustained. Recognized income tax positions are measured at the largest amount that has a greater than 50% likelihood of being realized. Changes in recognition or measurement are reflected in the period in which the change in judgment occurs. The Company's accounting policy for evaluating uncertain tax positions is to accrue estimated benefits or obligations relating to those positions.

(f) Income Taxes (continued)

The Company records interest related to unrecognized tax benefits as interest expense and penalties as an administrative expense. For the year ended December 31, 2016, there was no interest or penalties recorded because the Company has no uncertain tax positions that meet the more likely than not threshold.

(g) Cash Concentration Account

The Company's bank account is linked to the Parent's concentration account. Cash balances (or deficits) at the end of each day are automatically transferred to (or from) the concentration account, so that at the end of any particular day, as well as at year-end, the Company's bank account has a zero balance, with related amounts debited or credited to the underlying intercompany account.

(h) Allocations

The Company includes allocated charges from the Parent and affiliates in operating expenses. The charges are allocated by applying activity appropriate factors to direct and indirect costs of the Parent and affiliates or based upon established fees.

(i) Use of Estimates

Management of the Company has made a number of estimates and assumptions relating to the reporting of assets and liabilities and the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities to prepare these financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. The more significant estimates requiring the judgment of management include the valuation of the allowance for doubtful accounts and accrued franchise fees. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

(j) Stockholder's Investment

The Company has 1,000 shares of common stock authorized and 500 shares issued and outstanding with no par value as of December 31, 2016. Stockholder's investment, net is comprised of the legal capital plus cumulative contributions net of distributions.

(k) Fair Value of Financial Instruments

The carrying amounts reported in the balance sheet of the assets and liabilities, which are considered to be financial instruments (such as receivables, accounts payable, and accrued liabilities), approximate their fair value based upon current market indicators.

(2) Operations

The Company collects refuse and recyclables in the City of McMinnville and surrounding municipalities in Yamhill and Polk Counties. The Company's refuse collection rates are set by these municipalities. The rate setting process may result in the disallowance of certain costs and/or delays in cost recovery, as well as differences in the timing of when revenues and expenses are recognized.

During the year ended December 31, 2016, the Company disposed of the yard debris collected by its operations at a composting facility owned and operated by an affiliate.

(3) Commitments and Contingencies

Substantially all of the assets of the Company are pledged to secure obligations of the Parent. The Company, along with the Parent and the Parent's wholly - owned subsidiaries, has guaranteed the repayment, on a joint and several basis, of any and all obligations under the Parent's Revolving Credit Agreement. The Company could be required to honor the guarantee upon an uncured default event, as defined in the Parent's Revolving Credit Agreement. The Parent's Revolving Credit Agreement expires on April 12, 2018. At the Parent's fiscal year-end, September 30, 2016, there was \$23.0 million outstanding on the Parent's Revolving Credit Agreement and there were standby letters of credit issued for \$182.4 million. The Parent has represented to the Company that it is in compliance with all covenants of the Revolving Credit Agreement.

The Company, along with the Parent and the Parent's wholly - owned subsidiaries, has guaranteed the payment of amounts owed to unrelated third parties, which provided the equipment financing to affiliates of the Company. The affiliates are obligated to the unrelated third parties with various expiration dates through June 2024. At the Parent's fiscal year-end, September 30, 2016, the outstanding principal on the financed equipment recorded by the affiliates was \$59.9 million.

The Company and the Parent are involved in various legal actions arising in the normal course of business. It is the Company's opinion that these matters are adequately provided for or that the resolution of such matters will not have a material adverse impact on the financial position or results of operations of the Company or the Parent.

(6) Employee Stock Ownership Plan

In 1986, the Parent established an employee stock ownership plan and trust, which purchased all of the Parent's outstanding stock. The ESOP is a noncontributory plan that covers substantially all of the employees of the Company and other Recology subsidiaries. Employees, except under certain conditions, become fully vested after a requirement of three years of service. No vesting occurs until the full service requirement is satisfied.

The Parent's common stock is not traded on an established market. Presently, all shares are held by the ESOP. All distributions will be made from the ESOP in cash, which is received from Recology, or shares, subject to immediate repurchase by Recology. A participant who is vested is entitled to begin receiving a distribution from his or her ESOP account at a future date following his or her termination of employment. Distributions may be made in a lump-sum, equal annual installments over a period generally not to exceed five years, or a combination of the foregoing, generally as determined by the ESOP Administrative Committee (the Committee). The Committee also generally determines the time and manner of distributions, subject to the following limitations: (i) in the event of a participant's retirement, disability, or death, distribution must begin prior to September 30 of the plan year following the plan year in which employment terminates; and (ii) if a participant's employment terminates for any other reason, distribution must begin prior to September 30 of the sixth plan year following the plan year in which employment terminates, although the Committee may further defer distributions that are not attributable to post-1986 shares until the participant reaches the age that he or she would be required to reach in order to qualify for retirement under the ESOP. Each participant who has attained age 55 and has participated in the ESOP for at least 10 years may elect to receive cash distributions for in-service withdrawals attributable to post-1986 shares allocated to his or her account. An eligible participant is entitled to elect payment attributable to as much as 25% of his or her eligible shares during the first five years of election and up to 50% of eligible shares in the sixth year. The cash distributions are based upon the appraised value of Recology stock and other assets, if any, as of the most recent valuation of the participant's account.

The Parent makes contributions to the ESOP to make benefit payments to eligible participants under the Plan.

(7) Subsequent Events

The Company has evaluated its subsequent events through March 23, 2017, which is the date the financial statements were available for issuance.

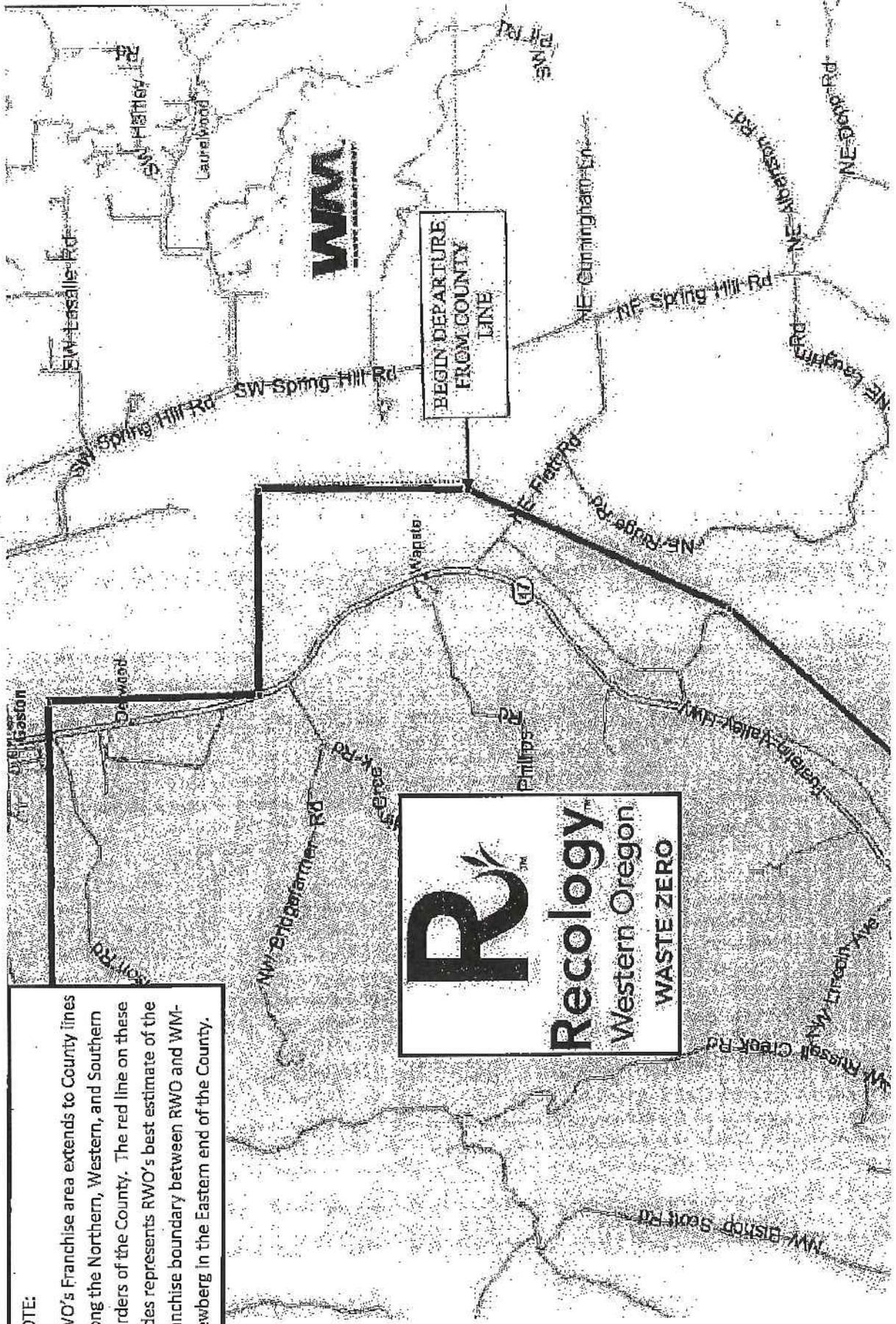

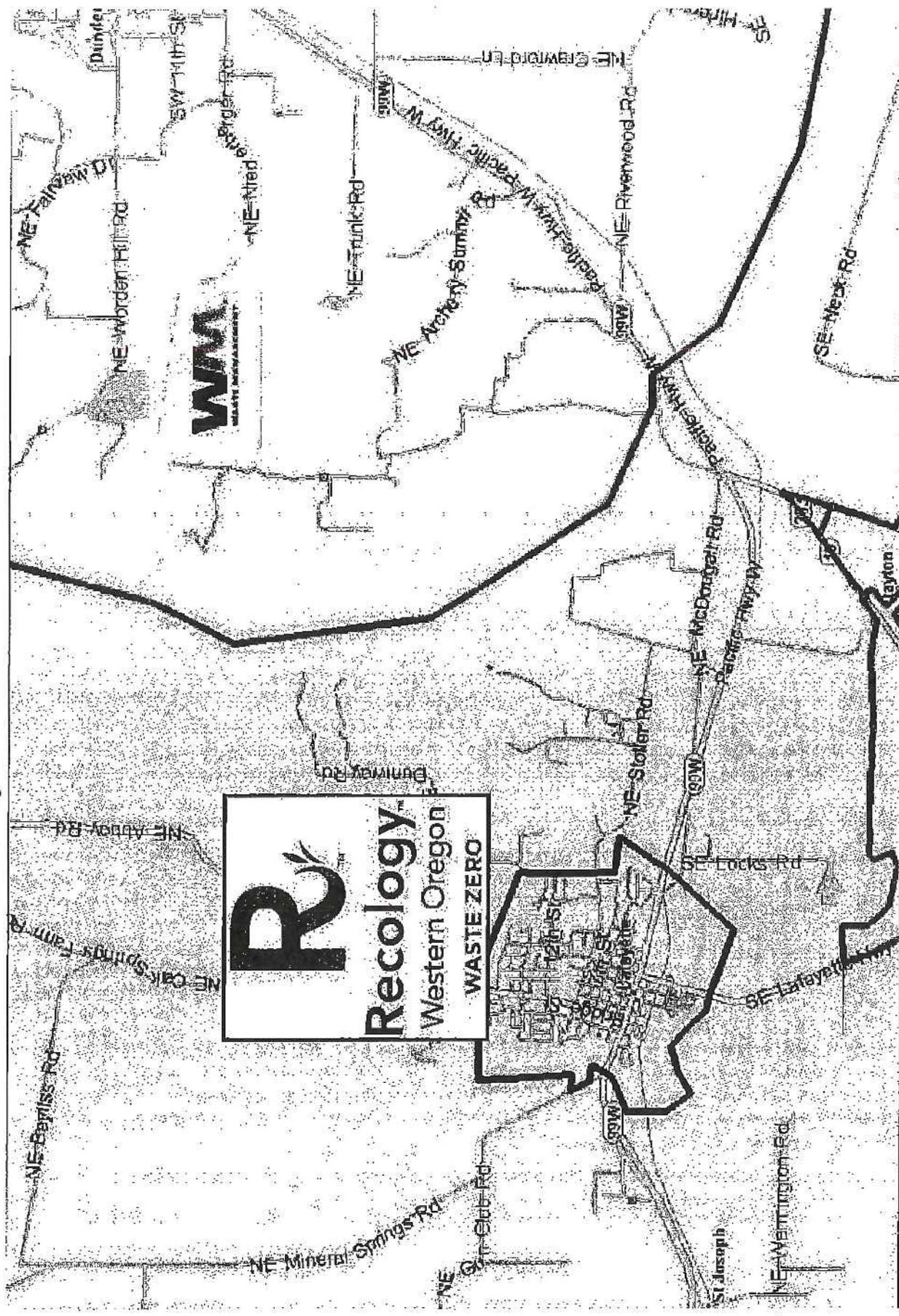
Yamhill County - RWO Franchise Area

4. Code Enforcement Report

Mike Kemper talked 2017 summary on solid waste violations investigated. 68 actively investigated, includes cases open prior to 2017. 53 solid waste cases closed, 2 citations issued. Average length 248 days, all solid waste 33 open and closed in 2017, average length 67 days. 11 solid waste violations opened in 2017 and remain open. 148 cases closed 2017. Average length of all cases 152 days.

5. Recology Franchise Renewal

Sherrie M: Recology gave app to renew another 10 years of their franchise. The ten years starts once app is approved by BOC.

Dave Larson from Recology passed out copies of application and went over details.

Nick: what is timeline for review? Is it open for bid from other companies? If the board decided not to renew, the county would put it out for bid once original contract expired.

Sherrie: It goes to Commissioners for vote

Jennifer: has the county ever put it out to bid?

Sherrie: not since I've been here.

Jennifer: when is transfer station complete?

Dave: Phase one complete, we are collecting from McMinnville, we ship it to Washington.

Jen: how much business?

Dave: about 52%

Motion to accept Recology contract by Kathy, seconded by Jennifer. Unanimously approved to send application to the board (Dave Larsen abstained).

6. Riverbend Landfill update Nick

This winter we prepped our slopes, hydro seeded, installed 12 additional wells that will provide high quality gas to our power plant. We will be busy this spring continuing projects to

Q: Steve, what percentage of electricity is being produced.

Nick: we run at 90% capacity.

Q: Jen: as a neighbor it has been more odiferous lately.

Nick: this could be due to drilling the new wells.

Q: Jen: do you think you have enough wells to adequately collect all the gas?

N: yes;

Q: Steve; what is the procedure to cap off a well.

N: we

7. Other Business

Jennifer: passed out info from hydrologist, Mark doing research on wells at Riverbend. He is concerned about older wells, increasing levels of chemicals, thinks chemicals are leaking into soil from the older cells.

Rick Olsen: I will recuse myself in case any of this comes up at BOC meeting.

Jennifer: It is something we need to be aware about as they might be putting more trash on top as it will be almost impossible to clean up if the wells start leaking into the ground water.

Steve: Jennifer, give us a chance to review this and look at the sampling taken at River Bend and revisit this at the next meeting.

Kim: who does the sampling?

Nick: a third party does sampling for RB, data given to DEQ and Mark is hydrologist analyzing the data.

Dave: at our next meeting it might be helpful to have someone from SCS (the third party doing the sampling) here explaining their data and sampling.

Nick: I will bring it back to my group and see if we can get someone here at the next meeting.

Jennifer: I think it is important that we need to educate ourselves as they are a big bureaucracy that are being sued in Portland for not doing their jobs monitoring the glass factories.

Dave: 320 cars at HWE last October, mostly paint. Prescription take back went well too. Nothing too crazy came in this year.

8. Public comments

Ramsey McPhillips, McPhillips Rd, McMinnville, or: I'm representing myself and Zero Waste: I still think you should dive deeper in regards to tipping fees. Reassess where you're going to get tipping fees, where are they, I think you might want to look into other options or groups before handing the franchise agreement over summarily. Zero waste has been here for 4 years and we are well organized. This seems like this committee should look into other options instead of automatically renewing a franchise.

Ilsa Pursc: is the transfer station at full capacity?

Dave: gave answer

Ilsa: are you taking any more recycling then you did previously?

Dave: no

Ilsa: since china is not taking our recycling where is it going?

Dave: various places depending on the type of material and season. I did not bring this information with me.

Rick: gave current trends, but if you can't sell it to someone, it will have to be landfilled.

Dave: if we collect it for recycling, it cannot go into a landfill, that it against the law.

Sherry referred to an article in the Statesman Journal. Also mentioned Adjulex is now taking all kinds of #6 plastics.

Jen: are you going to put a number 6 bin at Recology that you then transfer to Adjulex?

Dave: we should look into it.

9. Elect new Committee Chair and vice-chair

Dave opened floor for nominations for chair. Jen nominated John, Kathy seconded John.

Nick nominated Dave, Jennifer stated she didn't think it should be a franchise holder, should be a citizen. Dave nominated Jen, John seconded. Dave declined. Vote:

Vice: Dave nominates nick, Kathy seconds. John nom jenn, steve seconded. Nick: nick/john:jenn/steve:jenn/kathy:nick/dave:nick/jenn:jenn vote is 3:3.

Sherrie: if you don't mind holding off voting til next meeting for vice-chair, then we can have a tie-breaker.

Steve said we will put it on the shelf.

Kathy motined to adjourn, adjourned at 5:03.

You asked for a summary of the franchise fees we pay elsewhere.

Here is the info for the jurisdictions RWO serves:

Yamhill County: 2%

Amity, Carlton, Dayton, Lafayette, Yamhill (City of), Willamina, Sheridan, Polk County: 3%

Astoria, Seaside, Gearhart, Manzanita, Nehalem, Wheeler: 5%

McMinnville: 5% (recently increased, was at 3% until October, 2017)

Warrenton: 7%

Cannon Beach: 15% (recycling surcharge that funds a local recycling depot)

Tillamook County: \$75/truck/year (County receives revenue from margin on transfer station tip fees, does not charge a percentage fee to collection franchisees)

I have also requested this info for other jurisdictions from our industry group (the Oregon Refuse & Recycling Association). I will pass that along to you once I get it.
