

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
Sherrie Mathison**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 ("Amendment #1") shall be made effective as of July 1, 2018 by and between **Yamhill County**, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners ("County") and Sherrie Mathison, an individual, 3813 Coffey Lane, Newberg, OR 97132 ("Mathison")

RECITALS

A. County and Mathison are parties to that certain contract dated January 25, 2018 (the "Underlying Contract"), pursuant to which Mathison provides County with solid waste/disposal and related planning, development and inspection services. The Underlying Contract is memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 18-15.

B. County and Mathison now desires to modify the Underlying Contract upon the terms and conditions more particularly set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein below and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 4, subsection 1 of the Underlying Contract, "Term," is hereby amended to extend the Underlying Contract through June 30, 2019, unless otherwise terminated earlier in accordance with Section 4, subsection 2.

The balance of Section 4 remains unchanged.

2. Ratification. Except as otherwise expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment #1, the Underlying Contract shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. All terms, covenants and conditions of the Underlying Contract not expressly modified herein are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect, and constitute valid and binding obligations of County and Mathison enforceable according to the terms thereof.

3. Authority. County and Mathison and each of the persons executing this Amendment #1 on behalf of County and Mathison hereby covenants and warrants that: (i) such party has full right and authority to enter into this Amendment #1 and has taken all action required to authorize such party (and each person executing this Amendment #1 on behalf of such party) to enter into this Amendment #1, and (ii) the person signing on behalf of such party is authorized to do so on behalf of such entity.

4. Binding Effect. All of the covenants contained in this Amendment #1 shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, legal representatives and permitted successors and assigns.


5. Counterparts. This Amendment #1 may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Amendment #1.


