THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (“the Board”) sat for the transaction of county business in formal session on December 20, 2018, Commissioners Mary Starrett, Richard L. “Rick” Olson, and Stan Primozych in attendance.

THE BOARD MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS.

A. On December 16, 2009, by Board Order 09-835, the Board appointed Laura Tschabold to the position of County Administrator, and as such Ms. Tschabold assumed the role of county accountant. Ms. Tschabold is retiring, effective December 31, 2018.

B. On November 8, 2010, by Board Order 10-728, the Board appointed Deputy County Administrator Chuck Vesper and Financial Services Manager Becky Weaver as deputy county accountants; both Mr. Vesper and Ms. Weaver have retired from employment with Yamhill County.

C. On May 15, 2018 the Board appointed Ken Huffer as the new County Administrator effective upon Ms. Tschabold’s retirement, and the Board finds it appropriate to also appoint Mr. Huffer as county accountant, effective upon Ms. Tschabold’s retirement.

D. Furthermore, the Board finds it appropriate to continue designation of two deputy county accountants to act in Mr. Huffer’s absence or as he delegates. NOW THEREORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

1. Board Order 10-728 is rescinded.
2. The Board designates incoming County Administrator Ken Huffer a county accountant, to take effect immediately upon the retirement of Laura Tschabold.
3. The Board designates Business Services Director Justin Hogue and Financial Services Manager Mike Barnhart as deputy county accountants and authorizes each to act as county accountants in the absence of, or as delegated by, incoming County Administrator Ken Huffer.

4. The designation made under paragraph 2 shall remain in effect until the earlier of the following events: (a) Mr. Huffer leaves county employment; or (b) the Board rescinds this Board Order.

5. The designations made under paragraph 3 shall remain in effect until the earlier of the following events: (a) a named deputy leaves county employment; or (b) the Board rescinds this Board Order.
