Subject: **Renewal** – 30-Day Extended Detention Program

The Yamhill County Department of Community Justice - Juvenile Management Team has identified a continued need for our 30-Day Extended Detention Program (EDP). With limited statewide, non-custody programs, there are often long waiting lists for youth with behavioral problems, drug and alcohol addiction and co-occurring disorders. The continued use of our EDP will offer the juvenile departments additional time for appropriate placements, obtain screenings, assessments, and stabilize youth behavior or often allows for diversion from incarceration in the Oregon Youth Authority.

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 213-050-0060 set standards for the extended detention program. The current requirement for renewal is every five (5) years. Yamhill County Juvenile Department last renewed in 2014.

I respectfully request your approval to submit our application for renewal to the Oregon Youth Development Council for final approval.
