

AMENDMENT NO. 1
AGREEMENT FOR MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT SERVICES BETWEEN
YAMHILL COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND YAMHILL VALLEY TREATMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 ("Amendment #1") shall be made effective as of the last date set forth adjacent to the signatures of the parties below, between Yamhill County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon acting by and through its Board of Commissioners and its Yamhill County Sheriff's Office ("County") and Yamhill Valley Treatment, an Oregon nonprofit corporation doing business as Provoking Hope, 213 NE 10th Street, McMinnville, Oregon 97128 ("Contractor"), referred to individually as Party and collectively as Parties.

RECITALS

1. County and Contractor are parties to that certain agreement dated August 16, 2018 (the "Underlying Agreement"), pursuant to which Contractor supports Yamhill County in providing additional treatment options and services to inmates in YCCF with Opioid Use Disorder (OUD), including certified peer recovery mentor (CRM) support services. The Underlying Agreement is memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 18-300.
2. County and Contractor now desires to modify the Underlying Agreement upon the terms and conditions more particularly set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein below and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Underlying Agreement is hereby amended to extend the term of the Underlying Agreement May 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. It is understood by both parties that no commitments have been or are made by either party beyond the termination of this Agreement.
2. Section 6, Item A, is amended to increase the maximum not-to-exceed amount under the Agreement to \$55,000.00.
3. Section 6, Item B is hereby deleted in its entirety.
4. Except as amended herein, the balance of Section 6 remains unchanged.
5. **Ratification.** Except as otherwise expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment #1, the Underlying Agreement shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. All terms, covenants, and conditions of the Underlying Agreement not expressly modified herein are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect and constitute valid and binding obligations of County and Contractor enforceable according to the terms thereof.

6. **Authority.** County and Contractor and each of the persons executing this Amendment #1 on behalf of County and Contractor hereby covenants and warrants that: (i) such party has full right and authority to enter into this Amendment #1 and has taken all action required to authorize such party (and each person executing this Amendment #1 on behalf of such party) to enter into this Amendment #1, and (ii) the person signing on behalf of such party is authorized to do so on behalf of such entity.
7. **Binding Effect.** All of the covenants contained in this Amendment #1 shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, legal representatives, and permitted successors and assigns.
8. **Counterparts.** This Amendment #1 may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Amendment #1.
9. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are intended to be a material part of this Amendment #1 and are incorporated herein by this reference.
