**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY  
2019-2021 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE

This Sixth Amendment to Oregon Health Authority 2019-2021 Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services, effective July 1, 2019, (as amended the "Agreement"), is between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority ("OHA") and Yamhill County, ("LPHA"), the entity designated, pursuant to ORS 431.003, as the Local Public Health Authority for Yamhill County.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, OHA and LPHA wish to modify the Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) Financial Assistance Award set forth in Exhibit C of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows

**AGREEMENT**

1. Section 1 of Exhibit C entitled "Financial Assistance Award" of the Agreement for FY20 is hereby superseded and replaced in its entirety by Attachment A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Attachment A must be read in conjunction with Section 3 of Exhibit C.
2. LPHA represents and warrants to OHA that the representations and warranties of LPHA set forth in Section 2 of Exhibit E of the Agreement are true and correct on the date hereof with the same effect as if made on the date hereof.
3. Capitalized words and phrases used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Agreement.
4. Except as amended hereby, all terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
5. The parties expressly ratify the Agreement as herein amended.
6. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all parties, notwithstanding that all parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this Amendment so executed shall constitute an original.
