Hi Mary and Ken,

I would like permission to apply for up to \$650,000 in funding from the Oregon Health Authority under the Increasing Community Access to Care request for grant proposals. The funding is part of OHA’s implementation of Measure 110. While this funding is not specifically included in our Health and Human Services 2021-2022 Proposed Budget, we have sufficient budget authority to receive the funds if awarded.

This funding is intended to increase access to care statewide and improve outcomes for individuals actively using substances, engaging in substance misuse, or having a substance use disorder.

Our proposal includes funding to enable 24/7 coverage of peers (Certified Recovery Mentors) to respond on calls to support individuals being cited; funding for Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Services training for HHS and partner providers; and funding for palm cards that can be handed out in the community.

If our application is successful, I will return to the Board to request approval of the actual amount awarded.

Suggested Board Agenda Language: “Authorize Lindsey Manfrin or designee on behalf of Yamhill County Health and Human Services to submit an application for funding from the Oregon Health Authority to support increased access to substance use disorder services for up to \$650,000.”
