RE: Intent to Award the 2022 Highway Striping Services

BACKGROUND:

Each year the Public Works Department needs to re-strip approximately 700 lane miles of yellow centerline striping and 300 miles of white fog lines on County Roads. The Public Works Department contracts the work out to a contractor through a competitive bidding process.

On September 9th, 2022, the 2022 Highway Striping Services Project was advertised. Public Works received two (2) bids for work associated with the Public Works Striping Services. The bids were publicly opened at the Public Works Department on Thursday, September 15th, 2022, at 2:00 PM. The lowest responsive bidder was Hicks Striping, Inc. with a bid of \$288,547.50.

The County Public Works has reviewed the qualifications of Hicks Striping & Curbing, LLC., and recommends awarding the contract to them.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the 2022 Highway Striping Intent to Award Contract in the amount of \$288,547.50 to Hicks Striping & Curbing, LLC.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funds will come out of the Road Fund – Contract Services (This project is in the budget for 2022-23)
