



**#2 Project Description:**

Declare three YCT vehicles as surplus for disposal and approve for salvage.

**# 2 Board Action:**

Approve disposal and salvage of three Yamhill County Transit vehicles that have met the federal useful life standards and are damaged and not in condition to sell, units 000, 592, and 1305.

**# 2 Background Info:**

Two of the vehicles, 000 and 592 were totaled in a fire on 7-12-23. A copy of the fire marshals report is attached. First Transit's insurance adjuster inspected the buses this week and YCT will receive payment from First Transit for the vehicles once the value is determined by the insurance company. These vehicles were not purchased with state or federal funds.

The third vehicle, 1305 is well beyond its useful life and YCT attempted to make improvements to keep it in service due to shortage of vehicles but the latest estimate for repairs is over \$15,000. YCT has determined it is best to use this bus for parts to keep the other buses in this series on the road until new vehicles are delivered.

Below are the details for the vehicles. YCT plans to send these vehicles to the salvage yard after they are declared surplus and any useful equipment is removed.
