THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY ("the Board") sat for the transaction of county business in formal session on October 4, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 32 of the Courthouse, Commissioners Leslie Lewis, Kathy George, and Mary P. Stern being present.

WHEREAS the National Association of Manufacturers and the Manufacturing Institute have partnered to co-produce the first annual national Manufacturing Day on October 5, 2012, to highlight the importance of manufacturing to the U.S. economy and showcase the rewarding, highly-skilled jobs available in manufacturing fields; and

WHEREAS, manufacturers across the nation have been invited to participate in Manufacturing Day by hosting open houses, public tours, career workshops, and other events; and

WHEREAS, Yamhill County is fortunate to be the home of over 250 manufacturers, many of which are world-class manufacturing companies, and those manufacturing companies add to the vitality and prosperity of our community; and

WHEREAS, manufacturing careers and work settings are fundamentally different than they were a few decades ago, and modern manufacturing has become a sleek, innovative, technology-driven industry that offers secure, good-paying jobs; and

WHEREAS, a recent study shows that 600,000 manufacturing jobs are unfilled in the United States due to a gap in the job requirements and the skills within the workforce, and Manufacturing Day is an important step in helping to change manufacturing's image and engage future talent by giving them firsthand experience with the real world of manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, through the Mid-Willamette Valley Jobs Council and Job Growers, Incorporated, the Commissioners support our local manufacturers with workforce training programs, the High Performance Consortium, and Employer Workforce Training Funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim October 5, 2012, as MANUFACTURING DAY in Yamhill County, and in doing so, encourages all citizens of Yamhill County to join in recognizing the value of our manufacturers and the vital role they fill in our community.
