THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (“the Board”) sat for the transaction of county business in combined informal/formal session on Thursday, March 26, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., Room 32 of the Yamhill County Courthouse, Commissioners Casey Kulla, Mary Starrett and Richard L “Rick” Olson being present.

**WHEREAS**, On March 17, 2020 the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners formally declared a State of Emergency within Yamhill County to address the continued spread of COVID-19, memorialized as Board Order 20-93 and Resolution 20-03/17-1 (the “Declaration”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Declaration was set to continue until March 31, 2020, unless extended or earlier terminated by the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, the spread of COVID-19 continues to affect all of Yamhill County and the Board has determined that continued measures in the form of an extension of the Declaration is needed; NOW THEREFORE

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Declaration is hereby extended and shall remain in effect until June 30, 2020 unless further extended or earlier terminated by the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners.
