

WHEREAS, it is necessary to protect the fundamental rights and privacies of Yamhill County residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners recommends as follows:

1. No Yamhill County business, entity, board, agency, department, political subdivision, agent or assigns should:
 - a. Require as a condition for accessing services or facilities that an individual produce proof that he or she has received a COVID-19 vaccine before allowing them to enter without a mask or receive services; or
 - b. Require the production or issuance of a COVID-19 “vaccine passport” for the purpose of certifying that an individual has received a COVID-19 vaccine; or
 - c. Knowingly provide information of an individual’s COVID-19 vaccine status to any person company, or government entity for inclusion in a COVID-19 “vaccine passport” program.
2. All county agencies should work to ensure businesses are aware of this information.
3. This Resolution does not, and shall not be construed to, prohibit, restrict, or otherwise limit the right of an individual to access his or her own personal health information under state or federal law.
