and reaffirm Yamhill County's commitment to small businesses and to supporting them by shopping locally, dining at local restaurants, and utilizing local services they provide.


Let us acknowledge the hard work, passion, and resilience of our small business owners and entrepreneurs, and let us continue to foster an environment where they can thrive and succeed.
