the Practice of Electing the Yamhill County) ORDINANCE No. 881
Surveyor, and Declaring an Emergency)

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON ("the Board") sat for the transaction of county business in a combined informal/formal session on February 21, 2013, commissioners Kathy George, Mary P. Stern, and Allen Springer participating.

THE BOARD MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS.

A. Senate Bill 344 became law as Oregon Laws 2009 Chapter 491. Now codified as ORS 204.005 (2), this law provides that "(u)nless an adopted county charter or county ordinance provides otherwise, the governing body of a county shall appoint a county surveyor." Thus the county surveyor in a general law county such as Yamhill County is appointed unless the County chooses otherwise.

B. In 2009, at the request of the county surveyor, Yamhill County passed Ordinance 840 making the county surveyor an elected official. That surveyor has now retired, and the Board wishes to repeal Ordinance 840 and be consistent with state law by having an appointed surveyor. NOW, THEREFORE,

THE YAMHILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 **REPEAL OF Ordinance 840.** Ordinance 840, adopted September 2, 2009, is hereby REPEALED; and the Yamhill County surveyor shall be an appointed position pursuant to ORS 204.005(2).


Section 2 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The first and second readings of this ordinance were made February 21, 2013. To carry out the intent of this ordinance an emergency is hereby declared to exist. In accordance with ORS 203.045(4) this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
