ORDINANCE NO. 15

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Planning Commission has recommended a zone change for that portion of the premises along Three Mile Lane which lies North of the highway bounded on the West by the interim zone set forth in County Ordinance No. 6, on the East on the M-1 zone of the Johnson and Birch properties, and public hearing was had upon said proposed amendment before the Yamhill County Planning Commission after the proper notice as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Court, sitting in regular session for the transaction of county business, has approved the zone change for that portion of property described hereinbefore.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY OF YAMHILL ORDAINS:

Yamhill County Zoning Ordinances Nos. 1 and 13 are hereby amended to provide that the following described premises, to-wit:

A strip of land, 300 feet in width, lying northerly of when measured at right angles to the present center line of Three Mile Lane highway, said strip extending from the East boundary of F. W. Martin's Addition to the town (now City) of McMinnville, Oregon, westerly to the center of Pacific Street in said Martin's Addition,

is changed from Zone R-1 (Low Density Residential) to Zone C-2 (General Commercial.)
