This matter came on to be heard before the Yamhill County Court on the 10th day of August, 1966, meeting in regular session, County Judge C. N. Teegarden and County Commissioners Guy Shumway and Morris Majors being present, upon the recommendation of the Yamhill County Planning Commission that the governing body of Yamhill County amend Yamhill County Zoning Ordinance No. 1, Section 3, and Yamhill County Zoning Ordinance No. 1, Section 82; and

It appearing to the County Court that at a regular session of the Yamhill County Planning Commission held on the 19th day of July, 1966, the said Planning Commission, after a public hearing held on the matter, notice of which hearing was given as required by statute, has recommended to the County Court that the amendments hereinafter set forth be adopted for the area of Yamhill County outside the boundaries of incorporated cities therein; and after said hearing and recommendation, that the Yamhill County Court did, after proper notice given in accordance with the law, hold a public hearing on said proposed amendment, and did thereafter adopt said admendment; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1. Yamhill County Zoning Ordinance No. 1, Section 3, is amended to read:

(51) In each section of this ordinance when reference therein is made to the County Surveyor, this shall mean the Yamhill County Planning Director or his designated agent.

Section 2. Yamhill County Zoning Ordinance No. 1, Section 82,
is amended to read:

(1) Notice of time and place of public hearing before the Planning Commission and the purpose of the proposed amendment shall be given by the Planning Commission as provided in ORS 215.060 and in ORS 215.223, or in the manner prescribed in any law enacted by the Oregon State Legislature in lieu of ORS 215.060 or ORS 215.223.

(2) Recess of Hearing. The Planning Commission may recess a hearing in order to obtain additional information or to serve further notice upon other property owners or persons it decides may be interested in the proposed amendment. Upon recessing for this purpose the Commission shall announce the time and date when the hearing will be resumed.

(3) Notice and Hearing before the County Court. After the hearing and recommendations have been made by the Planning Commission, the County Court may hold a public hearing on the proposed amendment. Notice of such hearing shall be made in the same manner prescribed for hearings held before the Planning Commission on proposed amendments.
