ORDINANCE NO. 149

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Yamhill County, Oregon, on the 5th day of October, 1977, sat for the transaction of County business, in regular session, Commissioners Ted Lopuszynski, Colin Armstrong and John P. Macaulay being present.

WHEREAS, Margaret Hadley has petitioned for the naming of Market Road #32 as "Flower Shop Road", and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held upon the said proposed naming of Market Road #32 before the Yamhill County Planning Commission, after proper notice thereof was given, as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Planning Commission did, within reasonable time after said hearing, recommend to the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners the approval of said naming of Market Road #32 as "Stringtown Road", and the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners did thereafter adopt the recommendation of the Yamhill County Planning Commission; now, therefore,

THE COUNTY OF YAMHILL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

That Market Road #32 which extends from Highway #105 to Highway #150, be and hereby is named "Stringtown Road".

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance be filed with the Yamhill County Clerk, Assessor and Surveyor, as by law required.
