ORDINANCE NO. 182

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Yamhill County, Oregon, (the Board) on the 27th day of September, 1978, sat for the transaction of County business, in regular session, Commissioners John P. Macaulay, Colin Armstrong and Ted Lopuszynski being present.

WHEREAS, Earl Compton has petitioned for the naming of County Road #454 as "Patty Road", and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held upon the said proposed naming of County Road #454 before the Yamhill County Planning Commission, after proper notice thereof was given, as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Planning Commission did, within reasonable time after said hearing, recommend to the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners the approval of said naming of County Road #454 as "Patty Road", and the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners did thereafter adopt the recommendation of the Yamhill County Planning Commission; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNTY OF YAMHILL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

That County Road #454, lying in Sections 4 and 5 of Township 6 South, Range 4 West and Sections 32 and 33 of Township 5 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian as surveyed in the County Road Survey No. 337, and recorded in the CRS Book C, page 45 of the Road Survey Records of Yamhill County and accepted in the Commissioners' Journal 10, page 135, in May of 1889, said road extending from east right-of-way of Highway 99W to west right-of-way of Market Road #455, and being 1.27 miles long, be and hereby is named "Patty Road".

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance be filed with the Yamhill County Clerk, Assessor and Surveyor, as by law required.

DONE this 27th day of September, 1978, at McMinnville, Oregon.
