ORDINANCE NO. 187

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON, (hereinafter called the Board), on the 18th day of October, 1978, sat for the transaction of County business, in regular session, Commissioners John P. Macaulay, Colin Armstrong, and Ted Lopuszynski being present.

WHEREAS, the Board adopted, on the 8th day of September, 1976, Ordinance No. 110 which established a procedure and a fee for vacating public and County roads; and

WHEREAS the Board desires to establish a procedure and a fee for considering requests to name or change the name of County roads; and

WHEREAS the procedure established by Ordinance No. 110 would establish a reasonable fee and would be an efficient procedure for considering such requests, NOW THEREFORE,

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following is hereby added to and made a part of Ordinance No. 110 as Section 9:

"9. Whenever any person, group or organization requests the naming of any County road, or requests that the name of any County road be changed, the application shall follow the same two-step procedure as set forth herein for the vacation of any public or County Road. The fee shall be the same as for road vacation, or in other words, Fifty Dollars (\$50) for filing such an application and an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100) if the matter is set for a public hearing by the Board of Commissioners."

2. Except as expressly amended herein, Ordinance No. 110 shall continue in full force and effect.
