ORDINANCE NO. 228

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Yamhill County, Oregon (the Board), on the 30th, day of January, 1980, sat for the transaction of County business, Commissioners Ted Lopuszynski and John P. Macaulay being present.

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners finds that the regulation of cable television in Yamhill County is a matter of County concern; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That no cable television system may operate within Yamhill County unless it has obtained a franchise from the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2. The procedure for the granting of a cable television franchise shall be as follows:

1. That the Board shall accept proposals for cable television systems within the County.
2. That the Board shall conduct public hearings on the above proposals at a time it sees fit.
3. After public hearing, the Board may grant one or more franchises for a cable television system.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the people of Yamhill County, and the Board of Commissioners having declared an emergency to exist, it shall be effective upon approval hereof.
