THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (the Board), on the 13th day of July, 1983, sat for the transaction of County business, in special session, Commissioners Robin J. Hamblet, Dave Bishop and Ted Lopuszynski being present.

IT APPEARING TO THE BOARD that a procedure is set forth in the Solid Waste Ordinance for the establishment of Disposal Franchise rates and for the establishment of Collection Franchise rates, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE BOARD that the current procedures are independent and, as such, do not provide for simultaneous consideration of Collection Franchise rates when increases are requested by Disposal Franchises, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE BOARD that Collection Franchise expenses are necessarily affected by increases allowed Disposal Franchises, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE BOARD that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Yamhill County to provide a procedure whereby rate increases for Disposal Franchises and Collection Franchises are considered jointly, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE BOARD that the Solid Waste Advisory Committee has recommended that the following Ordinance be enacted by the Board; NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD that the Solid Waste Ordinance, as amended by Ordinances 154 and 192, be and hereby is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10.01 of the Solid Waste Ordinance shall be amended by the addition of the following subsection:

- i. (1) When an application for a rate increase is submitted to the Board by a disposal franchise, the applicant shall mail a copy of the application to all collection franchises which use the disposal site operated by the applicant as their primary disposal site. Any collection franchise whose rates are established by County may, within 10 days of receipt by the County of the disposal rate increase application, submit to the Board an application for a collection rate increase. Any such application submitted within the 10 day period shall be considered jointly with the disposal rate increase request pursuant to the process authorized by this Ordinance for establishment of rates.
- (2) When advising the Board on rate increases for collection operations, the Committee shall give due consideration to the formulas for establishing collection rate increases set forth in subsection (3) of this section.

(3) Collection rate increases authorized by this Ordinance may be established pursuant to the following formulas:

- (a) Drop box service rates based on cost per yard shall be increased by the amount of increase allowed disposal franchises for the cost per yard for the disposal of loose materials.
- (b) Container service rates shall be established upon the following basis: Where  $x$  = cost per cubic yard compacted,  $y$  = size of container in cubic yards,  $z = 4.33$  (average services per month), and  $r$  = compaction ratio, the monthly charge for weekly pickup service is equal to  $\frac{xyz}{r}$ .
- (c) Can service rates shall be established upon the following basis: Given that six (6) cans constitute a cubic yard, where  $x$  = cost per cubic yard compacted,  $z = 4.33$  (average services per month), and  $r$  = compaction ratio, the monthly charge for weekly pickup for each can services is equal to  $\frac{xz}{6r}$ .




