ORDINANCE NO. 370

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (the Board), on the 6th day of January, 1984, sat for the transaction of County business in special session, Commissioners Dave Bishop, Ted Lopuszynski and Robin J. Hamblet being present.

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of December, 1983, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 368 establishing a gross vehicle weight limit of 30,000 pounds for vehicles traveling the roads subject to County jurisdiction and establishing penalties for violation of said restrictions, based upon the deleterious impact of the severe freeze combined with the rapid temperature rise; and

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of January, 1984, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 369 which removed the weight restrictions established by Ordinance No. 368 as to certain enumerated roads under County jurisdiction, and whereas in the opinion of the County Roadmaster it is no longer necessary to prohibit the usage of roads under County jurisdiction by vehicles of more than 30,000 pounds, because the road bases have stabilized to such degree as will support vehicles subject to normal weight limitations prescribed by State statute; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board to repeal Ordinance No. 368, such that roads subject to County jurisdiction are not regulated by the emergency 30,000 pound weight limitation; NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD as follows:

Section 1. The Ordinance entitled "In the Matter of an Emergency Ordinance Establishing a Gross Vehicle Weight Limit of 30,000 lbs. for Vehicles Traveling County Roads and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof" adopted the 30th day of December, 1983, by the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners, be and hereby is repealed effective 11:59 p.m. January 6, 1984.

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Yamhill County, and an emergency having been declared to exist, shall be effective upon passage.


