THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (the Board) on the 21st day of May, 1986, sat for the transaction of county business in special session, Commissioners Donald D. Porter, David E. Bishop and Ted Lopuszynski being present.

WHEREAS, ORS 197.185 requires that special districts enter into agreements with counties to coordinate planning activities and to insure compliance with comprehensive plans and land use requirements; and

WHEREAS, Yamhill County and the L.A. Water Co-op entered into a Coordination Agreement on the 28th day of November, 1978, in compliance with ORS 197.185; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 299, adopted July 7, 1982, establishes the L.A. Water Cooperative Service Boundary as an overlay to the Yamhill County Comprehensive Plan Map of 1974 and adopts the L.A. Water Cooperative - Yamhill County Service Boundary Management Agreement as an ancillary document to the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, coordination of activities of the L.A. Water Co-op with Yamhill County Plan and Zone designations can be achieved without designating the Service Boundary as an overlay to the Yamhill County Comprehensive Plan Map; and

WHEREAS, the process of amending the L.A. Water Co-op Service Boundary and Management Agreement through ordinance has proven to be unduly cumbersome; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to readopt by order an amended version of the L.A. Water Cooperative - Yamhill County Service Boundary Management Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board conducted a public hearing on the 21st day of May, 1986, to consider the provisions of this ordinance; NOW THEREFORE,

THE YAMHILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. County Ordinance 299 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Yamhill County and an emergency having been declared to exist shall be effective immediately upon passage.
