

**AMENDMENT NO. 6
AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN
YAMHILL COUNTY AND SIEMENS INDUSTRY, INC.**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 6 (“Amendment #5”) shall be made effective as of the last date set forth adjacent to the signatures of the parties below, between **YAMHILL COUNTY**, Oregon, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon (“COUNTY”), acting by and through its Yamhill County Sheriff’s Office (“YCSO”) and **SIEMENS INDUSTRY, INC.**, a Delaware corporation operating locally at 15201 NW Greenbrier Parkway, Suite A-4, Beaverton, OR 97006, (“CONTRACTOR”), whose Federal Employer Identification No. is #J32762488.

RECITALS

1. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to that certain agreement dated December 19, 2019 (the “Underlying Agreement”), pursuant to which CONTRACTOR is performing a PLC/VMS system upgrade and installation as further described in the Underlying Agreement. The Underlying Agreement is memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 19-504.
2. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to an Amendment (“Amendment #1”) to the Underlying Agreement, memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 20-162.
3. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to an Amendment (“Amendment #2”) to the Underlying Agreement, memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 20-268.
4. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to an Amendment (“Amendment #3”) to the Underlying Agreement, memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 20-365.
5. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to an Amendment (“Amendment #4”) to the Underlying Agreement, memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 22-387.
6. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to an Amendment (“Amendment #5”) to the Underlying Agreement, memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 23-352.
7. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desires to further modify the Underlying Agreement upon the terms and conditions more particularly set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein below and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 3 of the Underlying Agreement is hereby amended to increase the total not to exceed amount by \$46,244.00, to cover the Additional Work (as defined below). Except as amended herein the balance of Section 2 remains unchanged.
2. Section 3 of the Underlying Agreement is hereby amended to include the following new subsection “g.”, which reads as follows:
 - “g. **Additional Work.** The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform, to the satisfaction of COUNTY and YCSO, and subject to the obligations and warranty provisions of the Underlying Agreement, the additional work described in the Attached Proposal, dated May 14, 2025 (referred to herein as the “Additional Work”), which is attached to this

Amendment #6 as Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by this reference. All Additional Work is considered part of the Work as defined and described in the Underlying Agreement.”

Except as amended herein the balance of Section 3 remains unchanged.

- 3. **Ratification.** Except as otherwise expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment #6, the Underlying Agreement shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. All terms, covenants, and conditions of the Underlying Agreement not expressly modified herein are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect and constitute valid and binding obligations of COUNTY and CONTRACTOR enforceable according to the terms thereof.
- 4. **Authority.** COUNTY and CONTRACTOR and each of the persons executing this Amendment #6 on behalf of COUNTY and CONTRACTOR hereby covenants and warrants that: (i) such party has full right and authority to enter into this Amendment #6 and has taken all action required to authorize such party (and each person executing this Amendment #6 on behalf of such party) to enter into this Amendment #5, and (ii) the person signing on behalf of such party is authorized to do so on behalf of such entity.
- 5. **Binding Effect.** All of the covenants contained in this Amendment #6 shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, legal representatives, and permitted successors and assigns.
- 6. **Counterparts.** This Amendment #6 may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Amendment #6.
- 7. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are intended to be a material part of this Amendment #6 and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Scope of Work

Based upon the drawings received, site visit, and a review of the working conditions, we have put together the following not to exceed proposal to install the additional Axis cameras and Ocularis software licenses.

Reference Number YCCF Room/Location Name

- 1 - Intake - Siemens to furnish and install new Axis M4327-P fisheye camera directly over the desk and view of the bench in the room. This will be a new camera with audio, and audio will be controlled with an on/off switch above desk (existing).
- 2 Intake- Turn off audio, no new camera needed here.
- 3 Professional Visit Room – Siemens to install a new Axis M3216-LVE camera in this location.
- 4 DUll Room – replace existing camera with higher resolution Axis P3267-LVE MIC camera with microphone to cover entire room and install an audio on/off switch on wall.
- 5 Deputy Ready Room - Siemens will re-locate camera #7 here
- 6 H Block – Siemens will relocate existing Axis panoramic camera from Admin Hallway and will mount on the drop ceiling once installed. Other three (3) cameras in this room will be lowered and mounted to drop ceiling.
- 7 Program Room- Siemens will install two (2) new Axis M3216-LVE cameras in new program room (currently YCCF staff/break room. In order to get full view with the column in the middle of the room, Siemens will need to install a second camera to ensure there are no blind spots in this room.
- 8 Admin Hallway- once removing the panoramic camera to be relocated at H Block, Siemens will re- install the existing camera from what will be the new DUll Room.

Clarifications

1. Network connectivity, POE switch, and static IP address at switch location provided by YCSO.
2. Existing POE switch to have open ports available.
3. Servers, workstations, and Ocularis base license provided by Yamhill County Sheriff's Office.
4. Abatement of any kind, patching, or painting.
5. Work to be performed during normal working hours, M-F, 7am-4pm.
6. 128TB Failover Server NOT included in this scope of work.
