ORDINANCE NO. 458

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (the Board) on the 27th day of January, 1988 sat for the transaction of county business in \_\_\_\_\_ session, Commissioners Donald D. Porter, David E. Bishop and Ted Lopuszynski being present.

WHEREAS, Yamhill County is a "general law county" operating under ORS chapter 203; and

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Surveyor is presently elected by the voters of the county every four years; and

WHEREAS, the board believes that the people of Yamhill County should have the right to determine whether the position of county surveyor should be appointive rather than elective; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature approved 1985 Oregon Laws chapter 756, amending ORS 203.035 in order to allow the Board of Commissioners to change the mode of selection of the county surveyor upon approval of the electors at a primary or general election; and

WHEREAS, the Yamhill County Surveyor's elective term expires on January 7, 1991; NOW THEREFORE

THE YAMHILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Commencing January 7, 1991, the mode of selection of the Yamhill County Surveyor shall be by appointment of the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners. The surveyor shall serve at the pleasure of the Board and shall be paid a salary set by the Board. Any person appointed as surveyor by the Board shall possess and shall be required to maintain the qualifications of a registered professional land surveyor in the State of Oregon.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be referred to the electors of Yamhill County at the May, 1988 primary election.

Section 3. Section 1 shall become effective if passed by a majority of the electors in the May, 1988, primary election. If this measure fails in the May, 1988, primary election, Section 1 shall be null and void and shall have no further force or effect.
