For the grant year FY25, Yamhill County Emergency Management has been notified of the following grant application requests:

COMPETITIVE GRANT APPLICATIONS

Yamhill County Sheriff's Office/Emergency Management - \$346,668

Yamhill County is seeking \$346,668.00 to fund contracted labor costs associated with the installation of new microwave equipment at all of Yamhill County's Public Safety Radio System tower sites.

Dayton Fire District - \$29,750

Dayton Fire is seeking \$29,750 to purchase multi-band mobile radios and tri-band portable radios to complete phase 5 of the communications project to provide interoperable radio communications to first out fire/EMS apparatus and personnel for emergency response.

Carlton Fire District - \$38,433

Carlton Fire District is seeking \$38,433.00 to purchase multi-band mobile radios and tri-band portable radios to provide interoperable radio communications to first out fire/EMS apparatus and personnel for emergency response.

McMinnville Water and Light - \$100,000

McMinnville Water & Light is seeking \$100,000, and will contribute (match) \$50,000, for the installation of a camera security system, alarm sensors (doors and reservoir hatches), and lighting improvements for the reservoirs and pump station to increase visibility and improve security.

ALLOCATION GRANT APPLICATIONS

The Cities of Sheridan and Willamina are using allocation funds to update the emergency operations plans for both cities.
