Primary Election to amend the Term Limits Ordinance.)

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON ("the Board") sat for the transaction of county business in formal session on March 29, 2001 commissioners Robert Johnstone and Thomas E.E. Bunn and Leslie Lewis being present.

THE BOARD MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:

- A. The Board adopted Ordinance 688 on December 14, 2000 to refer a proposed amendment to the Yamhill County Term Limits Ordinance to the voters in the primary election of May, 2002.
- B. On March 8, 2001 the Board held a public hearing on the Board Order necessary to adopt a Ballot Title for the proposed May, 2002 measure. Based on testimony received at the public hearing, a majority of the Board now believes it is not in the public interest to refer Ordinance 688 to the voters in May, 2002. This Ordinance is necessary to repeal Ordinance 688. NOW, THEREFORE

THE YAMHILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal of Ordinance 688. Effective on the effective date of this Ordinance, Ordinance 688 is hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

Section 2. Effective Date. The first reading of this Ordinance was made March 15, 2001. The second reading was made March 29, 2001. In accordance with ORS 203.045(9), this Ordinance shall be effective June 28, 2001.
