

No later than the **81st day before an election**, a governing body that has referred a measure must prepare and file with the local elections official the text of the referral for ballot title preparation or the ballot title for publication of notice of receipt of ballot title. This form may be used to file the text of the referral and request the elections official begin the ballot title drafting process or file a ballot title and request the elections official publish notice of receipt of ballot title.

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure. Shall the District assess \$1.6712 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years beginning FY 2026-27 to fund District operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.	
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect. This measure authorizes the Sheridan Rural Fire Protection District to impose a new local option levy to support District operations, including: -Increase staffing -Supplement emergency medical transport services and medical supply costs -Vehicle and station maintenance The District serves a population of more than 10,000 in a service area of 145 square miles. The proposed option levy would supplant an existing option levy of \$.88/\$1,000 of assessed value approved by voters in May 2022, which expires in 2027. If this measure is approved, the amount of the 2022 levy would no longer be assessed. If this measure is not approved, the amount assessed under the 2022 levy would continue to be assessed until expires. For a home with an assessed value of \$300,000, the levy would result in an estimated tax of \$501.36 per year. The levy is estimated to raise the following amounts: FY 2026-27 - \$1,051,976.00; FY 2027-28 - \$1,078,275.00; FY 2028-29 - \$1,105,232.00; FY 2029-30 - \$1,132,863.00; FY 2030-31 - \$1,161,184.00, for a five year total of \$5,529,530.00. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.
