Commissioner Starrett called the meeting to order at 2:15 p.m.

- * Personnel - Authorize the extension of the Clerk's Office summer intern temporarily help until September 8, 2016.
- * Contracts/Grants - see formal session agenda for details.
- * Resolution - Approve Resolution 16-8-4-1 to allow for the parameters of the Homestead Tax exemption as outlined in SB 1513.
- * Surplus - Authorize the Clerk's Office to dispose of surplus equipment.
- * Tax Foreclosures - Designate the Newberg Graphic as the newspaper of general circulation for publication of the 2016 Tax Foreclosure List.

Commissioner Starrett discussed the proposal of a letter of support for Parents' Rights in Education (PRIE) who are seeking clarification on bodily privacy issue and discussed the threat to remove funding from school districts for violation of the Title IX law. Commissioner Primozich stated that he is in total support of anything that supports local control. Commissioner Starrett stated that a local school will not lose Title IX funding if they choose to support local control and join the force.

All three Commissioners agreed to leave it as a non-consent item to discuss further at Thursday's formal session.
