B. DEPARTMENT UPDATES:

1. Planning Department – Ken Friday

Mr. Friday stated that permit activity has been brisk, slightly above last year. 4800 building and electrical inspections so far this fiscal year, on par with last year as well. Front desk staff is keeping up with permits and has received positive feedback for their interactions with the public. Mr. Friday reported due to a new state ruling that jurisdictions cannot have a contractor as a building official, Mr. Friday plans to meet with the cities of Amity and Sheridan to contract county inspectors for permit issuances.

Mr. Friday gave a personnel update; a new solid waste coordinator has been hired. The ADU Ordinance will be addressed at Thursday's public hearing for accessory dwelling units in urban growth boundaries.

Wolves and People Brewery have asked for an extension to allow food carts. The renewal will be an automatic 4 year extension if approved which is standard after compliance of conditions with an initial 1 year permit.
